



Interested in Trying Something Different on 5/21?

Our current league session is set to end on Monday 5/14 leaving us with an “open” week to do something different on 5/21 since 5/28 is Memorial Day and our next league will kick-off on Monday June 4th.

Here’s what I had in mind... wait for it... wait... I know you’re on the edge of your seat...

Team Cornhole and I don’t just mean a 2-player team. My idea for 5/21 knowing that not everyone will care to participate or will be available to participate is to take the FIRST 24 players to sign-up and pay the \$10/player entry fee. These 24 players will be split up into 4 teams of 6 players.

I will choose 4 captains of similar skill level (if they agree to be a captain) and these captains will choose their team. This is not like elementary school, we won’t line up and do this publicly as I don’t care to embarrass anyone. So this “draft” will be done privately until all 24 players have been selected. Once these teams have been determined, each 6-player team will then be split up into three 2-player teams. These 2-player teams will remain the same throughout the night.

Each 6-player team must discuss how they want to do this, do they want to put their “best” players on the same doubles team or split them up? You will have 10 minutes to discuss and determine your teams. After that you will then play every team from the other three 6-man teams which means you will play 9 games that evening.

Example: Team Weiser has 6 players (no, I will not be making myself a captain, this is just an example). All 6 players meet for up to 10 minutes to discuss how to form three doubles teams out of their 6 player team. These teams become Weiser A, Weiser B and Weiser C (in no particular order).

The other three teams might be Team Strzala, Team Havasi and Team Allen. Each of these teams will have 3 doubles teams. So Weiser A will play all three teams on Team Strzala, Team Havasi and Team Allen for a total of 9 games. If you’re not interested in playing 9 games, then this night is not for you.

The overall 6-player team that wins the MOST games, wins the cash. So this will encourage players to cheer for their teammates if they finish their game early.

This will be a fundraiser for the equipment fund, so it will be a 75% payout and thus, the winning team will win \$180 divided by 6 or \$30/player. It’s winner take all. Should there be a tie, then head-to-head will determine the winner.

Doors open at 5:30pm. ALL players must be available to arrive by 6:30pm. At 6:30pm the teams can discuss how to form their doubles teams (if they haven’t decided already) and games start by 6:45pm.

NOTE: If you want to participate it’s first come, first served to the first 24 players that hand me \$10. I am only opening this up to our league players for now, but if we do not have 24 players by the end of the night on 5/7, then I will contact some other people to see if they want to play.
