



Team Cornhole Returns on 8/27!

Limited to the first 24 league players to register and PAY!

The entry fee is \$10/player (must have played at least one game in the summer league)
You sign-up individually and teams are formed before the games begin

It is very important that if you sign-up that you show-up as this is designed for exactly 24 players

Each player will play 9 games and I do not expect to be done until 10:30/11pm
(players need to arrive by 6:30pm)

This will be held indoors at our new indoor league location:
American Legion Hall – 22001 Brookpark Rd – Fairview Park, OH Flyers

Format

I will choose 4 captains of similar skill level (if they agree to be a captain) and these captains will choose their team. This is not like elementary school, we won't line up and do this publicly as I don't care to embarrass anyone. So this "draft" will be done privately until all 24 players have been selected. Once these teams have been determined, each 6-player team will then be split up into three 2-player teams. These 2-player teams will remain the same throughout the night.

Each 6-player team must discuss how they want to do this, do they want to put their "best" players on the same doubles team or split them up? You will have a few minutes to discuss and determine your teams. After that you will then play every team from the other three 6-man teams which means you will play 9 games that evening.

Example

Team Strzala has 6 players. All 6 players meet to discuss how to form three doubles teams out of their 6 player team. These teams become Strzala A, Strzala B and Strzala C (in no particular order).

The other three teams might be Team Horky, Team Havasi and Team Allen. Each of these teams will have 3 doubles teams. So Strzala A will play all three teams on Team Horky, Team Havasi and Team Allen for a total of 9 games. If you're not interested in playing 9 games, then this night is not for you. I do not expect to end before 10:30pm and probably after that.

The overall 6-player team that wins the MOST games, wins the cash. So this will encourage players to cheer for their teammates if they finish their game early.

Each member of the winning team wins \$30 and each member of the second place team wins \$5. Should there be a tie, then head-to-head will determine the winner.
