



First Ever Team Tournament!

Fairview Park, OH – January 27, 2013

Cleveland Cornhole has a new format that will be used on Jan. 27, 2013. This event will feature not only teams of 4 players, but two divisions, so start forming your team now!

Each team will consist of 4 players. You decide who is on your team, however, “Premier” players may only play in the Division I tournament and each team of 4 can have a MAXIMUM of 2 “Premier” players on it.

So how do you know who is classified as “Premier”?

The list of players was created by the Cornhole Players Association (CPA) and has been secured so that not just anyone can obtain the list. The last thing we want is for this list to be used by other directors to BAN players from playing. Currently a lot of tournaments in the Midwest ban “pros” from playing based on the ACO and we do not want that to happen based on this list. Time – Doors will open at noon, games begin around 1pm. Please note that this event is a full day event since we are basically running 3 tournaments on one day. Each player will be guaranteed 6 games and probably MUCH more, so there will be a ton of cornhole played.

Format:

- All 3 tournaments are “CornholeBlogger format”, aka Holebrid in that they are double elimination (single games), but once you lose the best you can finish is in 3rd place in that particular tournament. This is being done due to time constraints. Also, each division will always compete separately.
- First up is the 4-man team competition. 4-player teams compete in a tournament as a team. 2 players from your team stand at one board and the other 2 players stand at the other board. Players will then pitch 2 bags per inning, rotating bags (first player on the team will throw the first and third bag while the second player would throw the second and fourth bag).
- Next is the doubles competition. Each 4-player team splits up however they want into two 2-player teams.
- Finally is the singles competition.

Scoring:

- Scoring is based on the number of teams that enter each division.
- **Example:** Six teams enter Division 1. Then each tournament would be worth a maximum of 24 points per player (or team) to the winner. The 4-player tournament would award 24 points for first, 20 for 2nd, 16 for 3rd, 12 for 4th, 8 for 5th and 4 for 6th. The doubles tournament would award 24 points for first, 22 for 2nd, 20 for 3rd... 2 for 12th. Finally singles would be 24 points for first, 23 for 2nd, 22 for 3rd... 1 for 24th. All ties in the bracket are played out. Then you total each teams total points together to determine an overall winner.

Entry Fee's

Division I - \$100/team or \$25/player

Division II - \$60/team or \$15/player (you may want to contact me to confirm you can play in Div II, it will be divided the same way as we have divided for previous events)

Prizes – 80+% overall payout in each Division!!!

***Note that if you must be cleared to participate in the Division II tournament**
